We contribute to protecting more lives from disasters and keeping a sustainable society to change people's consciousness by providing systematic and practical training programs on disaster preparedness.

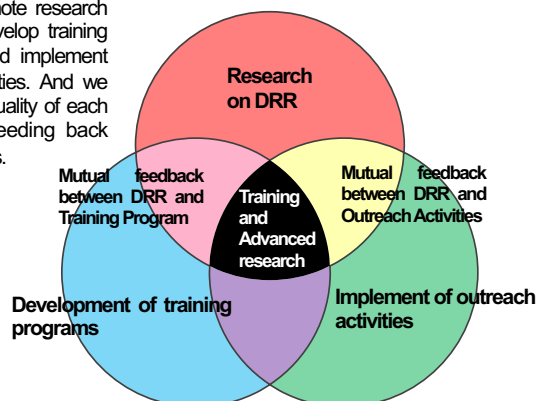
### Activity policy: For all Students

We will promote research on DRR, develop training programs and implement training activities. And we update the quality of each activity by feeding back mutual results.

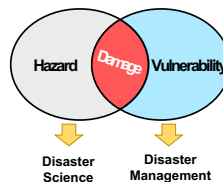


### 8 fields Core framework and 47 types of disaster management
